



The Southern Women's Domestic Violence Court Advocacy Service (SWDVCAS), auspiced by the Women's Centre, provides advocacy, case coordination and information for women and children who have experienced domestic violence and/or obtaining an Apprehended Domestic Violence Order. SWDVCAS supports two Local Coordination Points (Albury LCP and Deniliquin LCP) as part of the Safer Pathway Reforms. LCPs provide victims with information and referrals; and if needed, with case coordination, risk review and referral to a Safety Action Meeting held fortnightly in Albury; and in Deniliquin when required.
